Vladimir Šucha served as the Head of the European Commission Representation in the Slovak Republic (EC Ambassador to Slovakia) from 2022 to 2024. He was in the leading positions of the Joint Research Centre – a scientific and knowledge service of the European Commission between 2012 – 2019 (it is a type of science advisory posts and head of large research institution). He published more than 100 scientific papers in peer-reviewed journals. His expertise is covering Earth sciences, environmental sciences, innovation ecosystems, education systems, science-policy interaction, and prospective technological studies.
